



RULES FOR ARTICLE SUBMISSION

The articles published in *NUCLEAR ESPAÑA*, the SNE Magazine, will comply with the following rules:

1. They are original and will not have been published in other media. They may be transcripts of papers presented at conferences, but in this case, they must be adapted to the appropriate format for an article, and (for example, expressions such as “ladies and gentlemen”, references to slides, the conference where it was being presented, etc.,) will be omitted. Likewise, articles with clear commercial content should be avoided.
2. The responsibility for the admission of articles and their inclusion in the *NUCLEAR ESPAÑA* web portal corresponds to the Editorial Committee of the SNE Magazine.
3. The Magazine Editorial Committee reserves the right to suggest to the authors the advisability of making changes, extensions, or reductions of the text for reasonable reasons. No changes will be made without the consent of the authors, but in case of a serious discrepancy, the Commission may withdraw the article.
4. The SNE reserves the right to promote and disseminate articles on its networks.
5. Authors are responsible for the content of the articles published by them on the *NUCLEAR ESPAÑA* web portal.
6. When deadlines for the submission of articles are set, they will be respected without exceptions.
7. Articles must be accompanied by the following information:
 - a. The subject area where the article will be published, which will be agreed upon between the author and the SNE Magazine Editorial Committee. In the event that the article can be placed in more than one category, the main category must be indicated.
 - b. Title, which should not exceed 10 words.
 - c. Author(s), including Degrees, company or institution, and position.
 - d. Tags, keywords. Between 3 and 10 tags.



8. The following Technical Standards must be met:

- The article will consist of two texts:
 - An abstract with a maximum length of 600 words, which will be published directly on the web portal. Submission of a featured photograph is required and will be included with the abstract on the web portal. Minimum 1,920 pixels wide by 1,080 pixels high or high resolution is recommended. It is recommended to illustrate the article with two or three more photographs.
 - The full article, with a length of 3,000 words, including references and bibliography. The Editorial Committee, for justified reasons and upon prior communication, may accept a different length. Graphics and photos must be sent as original high-resolution image files.
- The texts will be sent in MS Word format.
- The documentation sent will include the name and surname(s) of the author(s), their current position and the company they work for, a recent photograph, and links to social networks. If not expressly stated otherwise, the authors will appear in the order in which they appear in the document. If the article has been done by more than three authors, no photograph of them will be included.
- Authors may include information from their social networks (LinkedIn, Twitter, Facebook, Instagram, blogs...).
- The article will be sent to the member of the Magazine Editorial Committee who acts as coordinator of the subject area that corresponds to the article, and who will be the contact person between the author and the Commission.
- To take full advantage of the possibilities offered by this magazine format, the publication of videos or multimedia content associated with the article on the Web Portal will be encouraged. Its content and duration will be agreed upon with the coordinator of the subject area.
- International System units will be used preferentially.
- It is recommended to use the terms from the nuclear lexicon defined at the following link: <http://www.sne.es/es/recursos/diccionario-de-terminos-nucleares>.
- The use of Bibliographic References will be limited to what is strictly necessary, and the Vancouver regulations for them will be followed, which establish that:

References will be numbered consecutively according to the order in which they appear for the first time in the text. Tables and legends will be identified in the text using Arabic numbers in square brackets. References cited only in tables or



in figure legends will be numbered according to the order established by the first identification within the text of each table or figure.

9. Outreach Articles will also be published in the magazine. These must meet the following additional criteria:

- The content must be related to scientific and technological issues, in any of the multiple disciplines, not necessarily needing to be connected to the nuclear world.
- Given the informative nature of the section, the articles should be written in clear and simple language, avoiding the use of technical terms.
- The results and conclusions expressed in the articles must be completely objective.
- The articles must not at any time express the opinion of the author or third parties.
- Likewise, articles with clear commercial content should be avoided.
- Articles should not cover topics such as religion, politics, or other topics that may deviate from the main objective of the section.
- Except for justified exceptions (for example, because they are of special interest), articles will be original and will not have been published in other magazines or media.
- The responsibility for the admission of articles and their publication on the web portal corresponds to the Editorial Committee of the SNE Magazine. The Commission reserves the right to suggest to the authors the advisability of making changes, extensions, or reductions of the text for reasonable reasons. No changes will be made without the consent of the authors, but in case of a serious discrepancy, the Commission may withdraw the article.
